Dolce Babies Class Policies

Eligibility

- Only one child may attend with one parent. Both parents may attend with a single child, but two children may not attend with one parent. A grandmother or grandfather, aunt, uncle, nanny, teenage sibling, etc. may also attend class with a child in place of a parent.
- One parent must attend the entire class with their child. No child may attend class alone, regardless of age.
- Children ages 3 weeks up through 4 years are eligible for participation.
- Guests (other parent, grandparents, etc.) may attend class free of charge. All guests are expected to participate in the class.

Schedule

- Class dates, vacations, holidays and Academy events are all detailed on the printed calendar and on our website.
- This is a 12-month, year-round program. The class is most effective when attended regularly for three consecutive years.

Absences

- Student absences cannot be credited or refunded.
- If you must miss a class, you may attend another class session on another day during that same week, providing that there is space available.
- There will be three make up class dates, spring, fall and summer, for those who have missed a class.
- If you must miss a class, please call, text (713-542-5428), or email. We will worry about your safety if you do not show up.

Payment

- This is a tuition-based program, not a fee-per-class program. Tuition is pro-rated over the course of the entire year, so the tuition is the same every month. You are not charged more for months that may have 5 classes in them and neither are you charged less for months that may have fewer classes.
- This is a continuous intake program, so enrollment may begin at any time. If you begin in the middle of a month, your first month's tuition will be pro-rated.
- Current prices are posted on our website, however, your tuition amount at the time of enrollment will remain in effect without increase as long as you are enrolled in the class without interruption. After stopping for a month or more, when re-enrolling, you will restart at the current tuition rate at the time of re-enrollment.
- 30 days notice is required to stop classes.
- All fees are non-refundable.
- Tuition payments are invoiced by email on the first of the month, for the month (or quarter) in advance, and are due upon receipt.
- There will be a \$20 late fee added to your bill if not paid by the 1st of the month (or quarter). Tuition is due upon receipt of invoice.
- Tuition may be paid by Zelle, PayPal, Venmo, or major credit card on an automatic monthly charge.

Illness

- **Do not attend lessons when ill. Students and parents attending in-person lessons when ill will be sent home immediately. This decision will be at the discretion of the teacher.** Please remember, learning does not happen when you or your child is sick, and it is not a good experience for your child. Please do not pass on contagious illnesses to us and all the other students and families in the Academy. The health and safety of everyone is of primary importance.

COVID-19:

- Since the onset of COVID-19, all lessons and classes have been online with Zoom. Online instruction will continue until further notice. We are continually assessing the relative risks vs benefits of in-person instruction and are taking the health and safety of everyone concerned into consideration.

Discontinuing Classes

- If it becomes necessary to discontinue classes, a 30 day notice is necessary.
- We may have to dismiss a student if any of the following circumstances occur: failure to pay tuition on time, failure to comply with Academy policies, or uncooperative or disruptive attitudes from the student or the parents.
